Local Community Mission/Outreach Services

The POHF will partner with local Atlanta-based organizations, along with the use of a medical mobile unit, to provide medical services to the underserved populations in our community. In doing so, we will decrease health disparities and promote health awareness by teaching prevention measures.

International Community/Outreach Services

Our goal here is to partner with local entities that have ties with non-governmental organizations in developing countries, which would serve to provide medical care targeted at reducing childhood mortality in these regions. Through short-term medical mission trips, we are able to help treat endemic conditions such as Malaria, Typhoid, and parasitic infections with medicine donated from sponsoring pharmaceutical companies operating in the United States.

Our primary goal is to support wellness in our local communities through prevention education and encouragement of healthier lifestyle practices. Once achieved, we implement short-term medical mission-style trips, which enable POHF to educate and treat endemic conditions such as Malaria, Typhoid, and other parasitic infections with medicine from the United States.
