<u>Health Awareness Health Fair(s)</u>

Each event will target specific health-related initiatives that will decrease health inequalities and increase health equity. Community collaboration is imperative, therefore, POHF will partner with vendors & merchants, board members & staff, county & state government officials, as well as with other medical providers in our areas to ensure success in each event.

Local Community Mission/Outreach Services

The POHF will partner with local Atlanta-based organizations, along with the use of a medical mobile unit, to provide medical services to the under-served populations in our community. In doing so, we will decrease health disparities and promote health awareness by teaching prevention measures.

International Community/Outreach Services

Our goal here is to partner with local entities that have ties with non-governmental organizations in developing countries, which would serve to provide medical care targeted at reducing childhood mortality in these regions. Through short-term medical mission trips, we are able to help treat chronic illnesses endemic conditions such as Malaria, Typhoid, and parasitic infections with medicine donated from sponsoring pharmaceutical companies operating in the United States.

Annual Black-Tie Gala

Our primary goal is to support wellness in our local communities through prevention education and encouragement of healthier lifestyle practices. Our secondary goal is to partner with local entities that have ties with foreign, non-governmental, organizations for the purpose of fostering relations with those countries that earnestly require medical outreach services. Once achieved, we implement short-term medical mission-style trips, which enable POHF to educate and treat endemic conditions such as Malaria, Typhoid, and other parasitic infections with medicine from the United States.
